The Street Team will be integral to the growth of the club by interacting with the community, providing information and collateral as well as opportunities for fans and followers to engage the club. These motivated individuals also execute interactive contests and giveaways. Future opportunities within partnerships, team-related activities, marketing and public relations may also exist as a part of this program.

- Commit to working the RIFC grass roots schedule which includes, but is not limited to, at least (2) two events per month
- Ability to work evenings, holidays and weekends
- Experience working promotional events
- Bilingual preferred, but not required (English with Spanish or Portuguese)
